Nominations are now being sought for the 2023 Barnet Civic Awards.

The awards are now in their 23rd year and are an opportunity for the borough to officially recognise the commitment and hard work of those who strive to make a positive difference to the lives of others.

The awards have become increasingly popular and this year we have three categories for you to make your nominations.

Each nomination will be reviewed by a judging panel and winners will be presented with their award by the Mayor in April 2023.

BARNET YOUNG CITIZEN OF THE YEAR

Criteria:

- This award recognises an individual young person or group of young people who have made a positive contribution to the community and demonstrated community spirit and a responsibility to civic life in the borough.
- They must be aged 18 and under.
- Nominations can be for excellence displayed in a number of areas including helping others, an outstanding commitment to caring for others or improving their community.

BARNET AWARD FOR OUTSTANDING SERVICE TO THE COMMUNITY

Criteria:

- This award recognises individuals or community and voluntary groups based in Barnet who have made a positive contribution to the local community, making an extra effort to bring the community together, or those who go out of their way to help others or a charity in their own time.
- The award is given to those making a difference to the community whether it's popping in on a neighbour every day, organising or supporting community groups or events or improving the locality for the benefit of everyone.

BARNET LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT CIVIC AWARD

Criteria:

- This award recognises an individual's exceptional and continued commitment to the life of the community in the borough over a considerable period of time and demonstrated an outstanding contribution to the local community typically for a period exceeding 15 years.
- The award recognises volunteering, community work, helping neighbours or carrying out exceptional deeds spanning a lengthy period.
